

St. Paul Parish Council Meeting Minutes
April 12, 2010

1. Parish Council Meeting opened at 7pm with a prayer.

2. Minutes of the March, 2010, meeting were reviewed by those in attendance and approved as written.
3. Monsignor Hickel's report :
Msgr. will address the Spring Appeal at Mass. He reported the boiler has been replaced at Church. He feels the cost will be between \$15,000 & \$20,000.
4. School Report:
Sharon Woebling reported on the recent School Improvement Report from the Archdiocese. The areas that will be addressed are more community service, teachers' professional development, and curriculum tracking. She will also form a small committee to address the facility issues that were noted by parents. Teacher contracts will go out tomorrow. There are 7 current school families that have not registered. The registration numbers as of now are 189 in K-8 and 21 in PreK. The consumables used at School are being looked at.
5. Auction Report:
Bill Alterson reported 250 people attended the auction. Everyone seemed to enjoy themselves and enjoy the food. He will have figures in the near future.
6. PSR Report:
Sister John reported 50 families registered so far this concludes to 70 children. She expects to have between 70 & 80 families registered concluding to 100 children.
7. Finance Report:
Ralph Lambert gave the budget figures through Feb. 2010. He also reported on next year's prepared budget giving a breakdown on figures due to the Archdiocese; subsidize figures to the School, tuition income, salaries, supplies and expenses. This shows a deficit for next year.
8. Other Business:
Ken Vomund reported to Deacon Jim work on the picnic is underway. They are working on advertising. Deacon Jim reported that have now completed the RCIA year and will be starting a new session. Bill Alterson brought up the idea for a master calendar for the Parish to maximize all the groups/clubs fundraising possibilities. All Parish Council Members should bring whatever dates they can to the next meeting to begin work on the calendar. Ralph Lambert noted the ACA presentation to take place this weekend at all the masses.
